


Safety notes

- Please read this instruction manual carefully before using this product, and use it correctly.
- The following warnings and cautions are important for safety, so please be sure to observe them.

All of these are important safety items, so be sure to follow them.

The contents to be observed are explained with the following symbols.



* After reading this instruction manual, fill in the date of purchase, customer's name, address, and the store name in the warranty column below, and store it in a place where users can easily access it.





This product uses a lithium-ion battery, so do not use, charge or leave it in a place subject to heat, high temperature or high humidity. There is a risk of failure or fire due to ignition or generation of heat.



Do not disassemble, repair, or modify this product by yourself. There is a risk of injury, fire and electric shock.



Keep out of reach of children. If you have a physical disability, please do not use it without an attendant. There is a risk of injury, fire and electric shock.



Do not use or leave near flammable materials such as cloth or paper. There is a risk of fire.



This product is not waterproof. Do not touch it with wet hands, splash it with water, wash it, or use or store it in a bathroom or other places with water. Also, do not use it when your hair is wet. There is a risk of failure, electric shock, and fire.



Do not use this product PELOUSA for any purpose other than pubic hair trimmer (unwanted hair heat treatment). There is a risk of failure, injury, electric shock, ignition or fire.



Do not use this product if you are pregnant, breastfeeding, menstruating, have allergies, have sensitive skin, are in the hospital, or have any other medical condition. If you absolutely want to use it, consult a doctor.

! Caution



Do not place the tip of the comb of PELOUSA on your skin for more than 5 seconds. It may cause burns.

Never use your fingers to pinch your skin between the gaps of the comb. It may cause burns.

Do not use it for more than 10 minutes continuously. When the comb becomes hot, even within 10 minutes, turn off the power and allow it to cool before using it again. Using it while it is hot may cause burns.



Please use 100v to 220v USB Type-C for charging. Never use any other charger. It may cause failure, ignition, or fire.

Precautions



This product PELOUSA emits smoke because the hair is burned during use. For safety, the heat switch automatically turns off the heater circuit when pressed for 10 seconds. If the heater turns off, take your finger off the heat switch and press it again.



The heat switch cannot be pressed unless the main power is turned on. For safety, the wire will not heat up if you do not press the heat switch for 1 minute while the main power is on. In that case, turn off the main power, turn it on again, and press the heat switch.



Burned hair may accumulate in the comb when using this product. In that case, press the comb open button and use a cotton swab to gently remove the remaining hair in the comb. Be careful not to press the cotton swab strongly against the heating wire. It may cause failure or damage.




After using PELOUSA, lather soap well with a body towel or body sponge to wash away any burned residue left on the tips of the hair.



The heat wire cartridge is a replaceable item. After using for a certain amount of time, the heat wire may become deformed, bent, or cut. In that case, replace the heat wire cartridge (Sold separately).

Name of each part / function



When the main power is turned on, the battery charge remaining indicator (blue LED) lights up, and the P logo starts blinking. When you press the heat switch, the P logo will stop blinking, and a beeping sound will be heard.

Safety function

- ①The main power will automatically turn off in 1 minute if the heat switch is not pressed.
- ②The heat switch automatically turns off after being held down for 10 seconds. It can then be used by pressing it again.
- *Please do not continue using it for more than 10 minutes continuously. The tip comb may become hot.
- 3The power cannot be turned on unless the heat wire cartridge is installed.
- For safety, the device is designed to turn off the power if the comb is accidentally opened during use. Please switch it on again to use.

How to use (long hair)

When using PELOUSA for the first time, when the hair is long, pinch the hair firmly with your middle finger, forefinger, and thumb. Hold PELOUSA parallel to your skin, and burn off the hair.



How to use (medium hair)

To further shorten the hair (3 to 4 cm), place the comb of PELOUSA firmly to the skin at an angle of about 20 to 40 degrees and burn off the hair.



How to use (short hair)

To make the hair shorter than 2 cm, or if you want to trim the soft part of the skin (U line), place the PELOUSA vertically on the skin and move it back and forth to burn off the hair in the same way as using an electric razor.





Never pinch the skin with your fingers and press PELOUSA against it, or never pinch your skin between Caution the gaps of the comb. It may cause burns.



Care after grooming

After grooming, lather soap well with a body towel or body sponge to wash away any burned residue left on the tips of the hair.


Care during use

Burned hair may accumulate in the comb when using this product. In that

case, press the comb open button and use a cotton swab to gently wipe out the remaining hair in the comb. Be careful not to press the cotton swab strongly against the heat wire. It may cause malfunction or damage.


Cleaning of the main body

After using PELOUSA, press the comb open button and use a cotton swab or a soft toothbrush to wipe off the remaining hair in the main body. Do not press cotton swabs against the heat wire. It may cause malfunction or damage.



Heat wire cartridge replacement

The heat wire cartridge is a replaceable item. If the heat wire is deformed or bent, the comb itself may become deformed by heat. If the heat wire is cut, the power will not turn on. Stop using it immediately and replace the heat wire cartridge.



Charging method

When the blue battery charge remaining indicator blinks less than before, charge with a commercially available USB Type-C or Micro USB with a USB Type-C adapter. When the four blue battery charge remaining indicators light up, the battery is fully charged.

Troubleshooting

Main power does not turn on (switch does not turn on)
 Is the battery charged? Plug in the charging cable, turn on the main power, and check the battery charge remaining indicator.
 *Please check again before requesting repair.

If the heat wire in the cartridge is deformed, bent or cut, the power may not turn on. In that case, replace the heat wire cartridge. (Sold separately)

■Heat switch does not turn on Slide up the main power switch and then slide it down again.
